

Statistics

- 1 in 3 women & 1 in 5 men
- 80% before the age of 25
- 30% before age 18
- 1,795 people served by MA DV services (24 hrs)
- 65% transgender MA bathroom harassment
- 911 = 8 taps (avg.)
- Boston response time: **6.4 minutes**
- PTSD = 81%





Consent is Sexy

- 1. Consent is a clear "Yes", not the absence of "No".
- Consent is reversible at any time.
- Consent cannot be given if you are any of the following:
 - a. Underage (under 16)
 - b. Intoxicated
 - c. Incapacitated
 - d. Mentally Impaired
 - e. Unconscious/Asleep

Relationship Rights

- 1. Right to Privacy
- 2. Right to Safety & Respect
- 3. Right to Choose Your Partner
- 4. Right to Say "Yes" or "No" to Sex
- 5. Right to Have Friends Without Jealousy/Interference
- 6. Right to End a Bad Relationship
- 7. Right to Live Free From Violence and Abuse
